



OPTION ONE /GONDAR/ - 3 DAY PACKAGE

Day 01: Fly Addis - Gondar

You will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Gondar. Up on arrival start to explore the city, emperor Fasilides founded Gondar as his imperial seat in 1636 and the city was both the capital and a great commercial center from 17th to the mid-19th century. Visit the Royal Enclosure or *Fasil Gibbi* within the compound and also the castles built by the various emperors of Gondar. A 2 km drive from the town center you will bring you to the bath of King Fasilides, where, during at Timkat (Ethiopian Epiphany) a nearby river is diverted to fill an area the size of a small swimming pool. Worshippers plunge into the cold water in a re-enactment of the baptism of Christ in the River Jordan. Continue drive 2 km to the north east of the Royal Enclosure to visit the Debre Birhan Selassie church, the only church that was saved from Mahdist invasion in the 1880s. According to legend, a swarm of bees routed the invaders. The walls and ceiling of this church are completely covered with murals - the angels' faces on the ceiling have become a common motif in Ethiopian design. **Overnight at Taye Belay Hotel / similar.** www.tayebelayhotel.com



Day 02: Excursion to Semein Mountain ~ 140 km

This day you will drive to Sanqaber a segment of the Semen Mountain. This is a sight, which is termed as the most wild and spectacular of all Ethiopian landscapes - 'The roof of Africa.'

Observe the magnificent scenery. En route visit the Felasha Village observe the magnificent scenery with unique flora. Here you can see the endemic *Gelada* baboons and endemic birds like Lammergeyer. Later drive back to Gondar for overnight. **Overnight at Taye Belay Hotel/ similar.** www.tayebelayhotel.com

Day 01: Fly to Lalibela

You will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Lalibela. Upon arrival start to explore the town, visit the internationally renowned rock Hewn churches known as 'Eight wonders of the world' the Lalibela rock hewn churches, physically praised from the rock in which they stand, these towering edifices seem to be superhuman creation in scale workmanship and concept. Some are sculpted out of solid volcanic rock. Others are connected by long underground tunnels and mazes. Some are quarried enlargements of caves. Your visit in Lalibela is said to be a great experience in life. Lalibela is the jewel in the crown of Ethiopia, the most famous churches and the scene of so many major religious ceremonies. The churches are carved below ground level and ringed by trenches and courtyards and are arguably Ethiopia's top most attraction. They are connected to each other by a tangled maze of tunnels and passages. Among the churches you will visit are Bete Amanuel a 36-foot-high monolith considered by art historians to be the finest and most precisely worked church in Lalibela, possibly because it was the private church of the royal family, Bete Markorios a cave church originally used for secular purposes and thought to be around 1,400 years old and Bete Giorgis the most majestic and best preserved of all Lalibela's churches. **Overnight at Mountain View Hotel/similar.**

Day 02: Sightseeing Lalibela

After having breakfast continue to visit the second group of churches Bet Giyorgis possibly the most elegant of all the Lalibela churches, lies somewhat isolated in the southwest part of the village on a sloping rock terrace. It can only be reached through a tunnel. The group of four, south of the Jordan River, comprise of Bet Emanuel, Bet Mercurios, Bet Abba Libanos and Bet Gabriel - Rufa'el. Bet Emanuel's elaborate exterior is much praised by art historian. In the afternoon take an excursion to visit Nakuto Le'abe monastery. King Nakuto abdicated his throne in 1270 AD and went to a cave to lead

a hermit's life. This cave has ever since become a monastery and has dramatic setting. **Overnight at Mountain View/ similar www.mountainsviewhotel.com**



Day 01: Fly Addis - Axum

You will be transferred to the airport for your flight back to Axum. Up on arrival check-in to your hotel then start exploring the city of Axum from around 200 BC to 700 AD, Axum was the seat of an Empire which extended across the Red Sea to Arabia, traded with India and China, had its own alphabet and notational system, constructed great engineering works and dams and which was reckoned in the 4th century to be one of the four great powers of the ancient Chapel within the church World. Continue visiting Axum Museum and Mariam TSION Church, built on the site of Ethiopia's first church. A compound is believed by Ethiopian Orthodox Christians to house the Ark of the Covenant, or the original tablets of Moses. **Overnight at Sabean International Hotel/Similar.** www.sabeanhotel.com



Day 02: Drive Axum - Mekele

You use the town as the base from which to visit Yeha or Debra Damo. Yeha is famous for its huge and remarkable temple. According to the 19th century German scholar Heinrich Müller, the temple is thought to date back to about seven or eight hundred years before the birth of Christ. The temple is believed to be the oldest standing building in the country. Beside the remarkable temple, a church dedicated to Abba Aftse stands. Abba Aftse was one of the famous nine saints who came to Ethiopia in the 6th century from the east Roman Empire to teach the Gospel. The church, sharing the same compound with the temple is rectangular in shape. If time allows you will visit Debre Damo monastery accessible only by rope and not allowed for women visitor. It is flat-topped peak, the oldest and the most distinguished marvel. **Overnight at Axum Hotel.**
