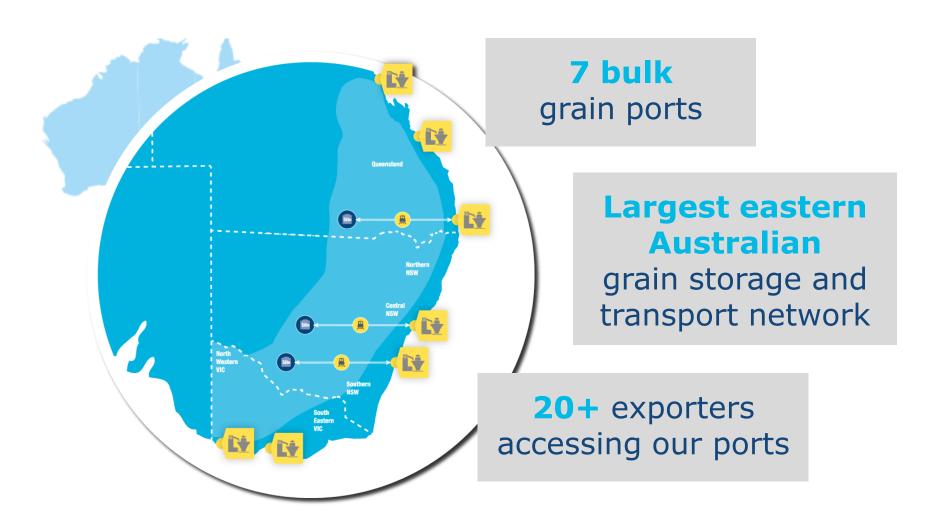

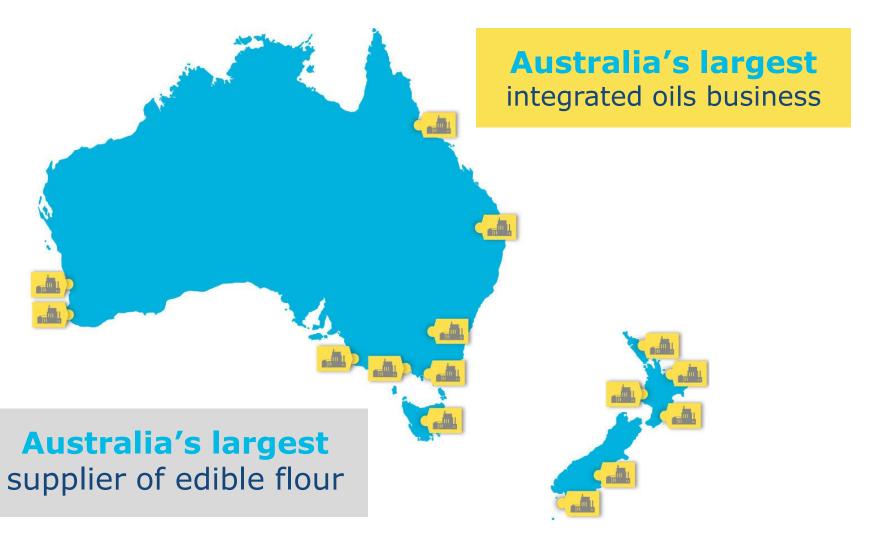

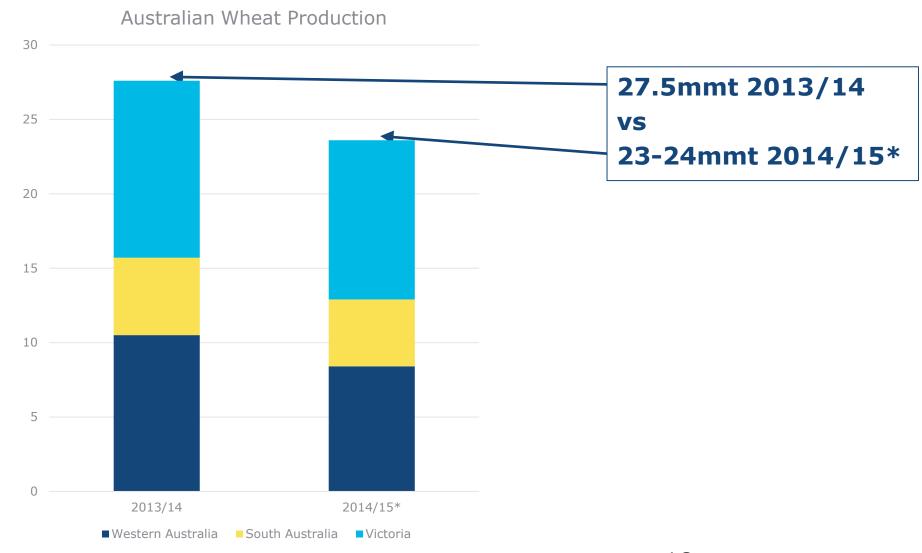

The 2014 / 15 Harvest

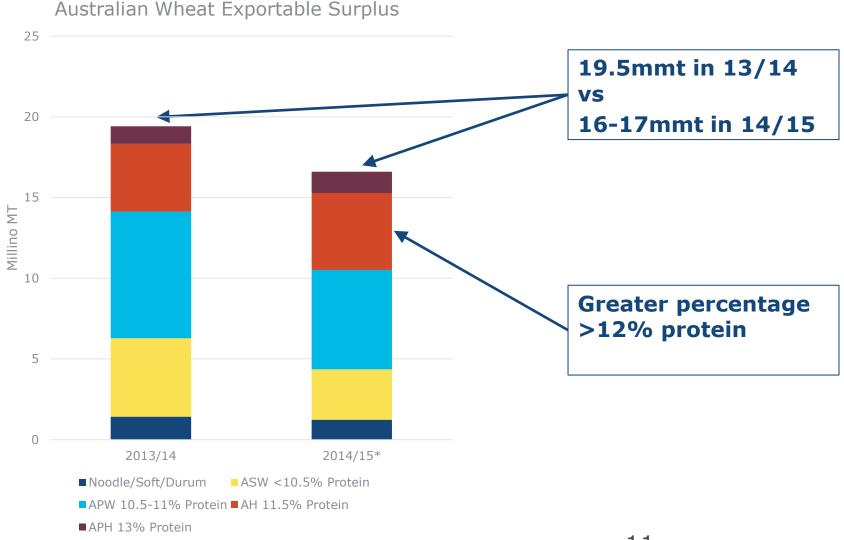
Lower 14/15 Wheat Production





Smaller 14/15 Exportable Surplus

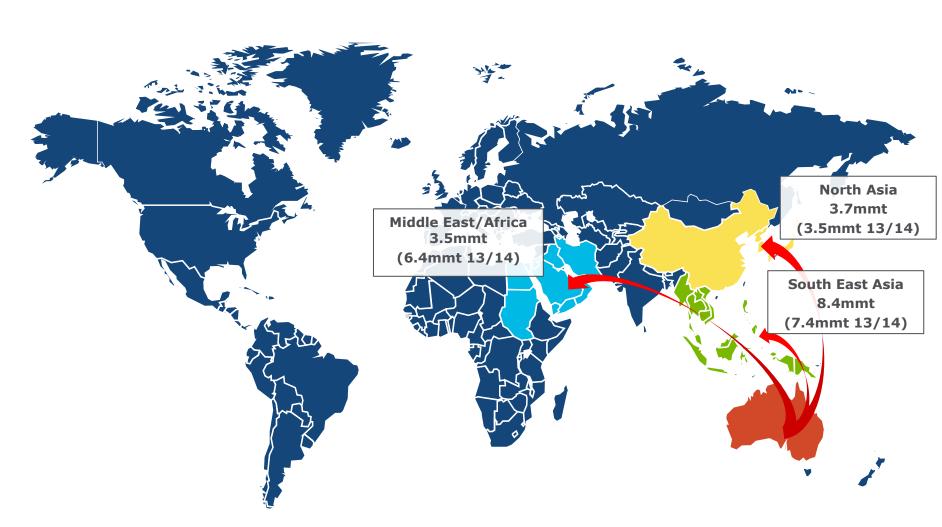




Lower Australian Exports to Middle East/Africa

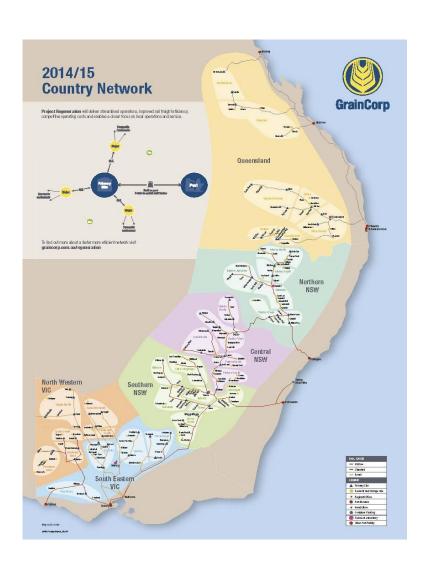
