




Evolution of wheat area (Mons ha)


Slight decrease in 2012 (-2% vs. 2011) due to freeze damage in the eastern part of the country in February



Wheat collecting density (FranceAgriMer)




Evolution de la température en France au cours de l'hiver 2011-2012




Cumul de précipitations : printemps 2012 Rapport à la moyenne de référence 1981-2010



Température moyenne : printemps 2012 Ecart à la moyenne de référence 1981-2010




Température moyenne : été 2012 Ecart à la moyenne de référence 1981-2010



An increased availability (+ 2 Mons t) in a tight market








French wheat balance

Depending on collecting rate and export to EU, Export to countries outside EU is forecasted between 9.5 and 11 Mons t




World market share of French wheat (including EU exchanges)

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

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

Conclusion 1

- > France is one of the first wheat producing countries in the world, behind China, India, USA and Russia, and a major contributor to the world wheat market,
- Thanks to its temperate oceanic climate, to its soils, and to the know how of wheat producers, French wheat production is quite regular from one year to another, enabling a stable and reliable contribution to the world wheat market,



- > For the on going 2012-2013 marketing year, French production is 2 Mons t more than last year, available for the export market,
- >Purchase of French wheat is always free, with no restriction to exports



2012 French wheat quality






- > A double survey carried out by Arvalis (technical Institute) and FranceAgriMer (French Ministry of Agriculture),
- > 1320 samples collected in the fields,
- > 600 samples collected in silos,
- > Analysed by Arvalis and FranceAgriMer,
- **▶**To give a overview of 2012 harvest quality : average values and distribution,
- >The role of traders is to mix different batches to meet customer's requirements.



Most of wheat varieties suitable for bread making







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

Conclusion 2

- > Most wheat grown in France is of milling quality,
- > French wheat quality is quite stable from year to year. As usual, 2012 French wheat is characterized by an average protein and gluten content, but a high protein quality, and a high gluten index,
- >2012 French wheat is thus suitable, alone or combined with other origins, for a great variety of products like French baguette, but also different kinds of flat breads.
