

These industries strongly contribute to the competitiveness of Tunisia in the exportation of different products to various countries. The economy of the region is facilitated by Sousse's seaport, the two nearby airports of Monastir and Enfidha and a strong highways infrastructure linking Sousse to Tunis and Sfax in 90 minutes and to Kairouan, El Djem, Mahdia, Nabeul and Hammamet in one hour.

Moreover, Sousse is an important tourism hub with its hotel complexes and fine sandy beaches. The city has a capacity of 40 thousand beds extending 20 km from the downtown Boujaafar beachfront to the famous Port El Kantaoui.

This year's venue is the Môvenpick Resort and Marine Spa Sousse located in the downtown area on the seafront, offering different facilities, such as ATMs, cafés, restaurants, shops and spa.






